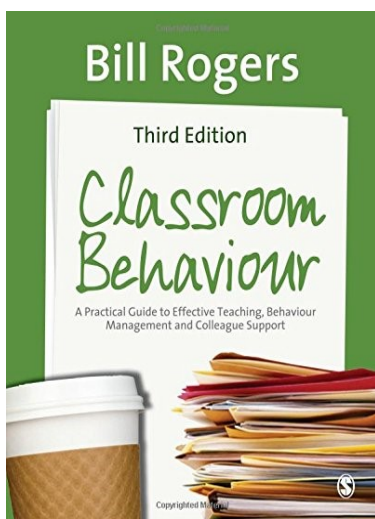
### **September return:**
